January 3, 2017 Cottonwood County Board of Commissioners Regular Meeting Minutes

The Cottonwood County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, January 3, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. at the Cottonwood County Courthouse in Windom, MN. Present for all or portions of the meeting were: Commissioners Tom Appel, Donna Gravley, Jim Schmidt, Kevin Stevens, Norm Holmen; County Coordinator Kelly Thongvivong; Auditor/Treasurer Jan Johnson; County Attorney Nick Anderson, Kathy Marsh, Glenn Johnson, Crystal Reith, JinYeene Neumann, Kyle Pillatzki, Jed Rhubee, and Rahn Larson

Auditor/Treasurer Jan Johnson called the meeting to order and distributed the oaths of office to Commissioners Kevin Stevens and Norm Holmen.

Johnson then asked for nominations for Board Chairman. Motion by Holmen, second by Schmidt, unanimous vote to elect Commissioner Appel and to ask that all nominations cease and to cast a unanimous ballot for Appel as Board Chairman for 2017. Presiding over the remainder of the meeting was Chairman Tom Appel.

Appel then asked for nominations for Board Vice-Chairman. Motion by Schmidt, second by Stevens, unanimous vote to elect Commissioner Gravley and to ask that all nominations cease and to cast a unanimous ballot for Gravley as Vice-Chairman for 2017.

Motion by Schmidt, second by Stevens, unanimous vote to approve the agenda as amended. Motion by Schmidt, second by Gravley, unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the December 20, 2016 meeting.

Glenn Johnson, Director of Information Systems, met with the board to discuss a few items. Johnson presented two fiber locating services contracts from USIC. Johnson stated that USIC has done fiber locating for us in 2016 and now require a contract. Contract #1 is for \$2,000 with USIC having no liability. Contract #2 is for \$5,000 with USIC having a liability limit of \$5,000. After much discussion, consensus of the board is to research other options available and bring back to the board.

Johnson informed the board that he has received an invoice from the SWCD Office for rental space for the GIS employee. Johnson stated that he does not have a budgeted line item for rent. Commissioner Appel stated to hold off on paying this invoice until he can have further discussions with Kay Gross, SWCD District Manager.

Crystal Reith, 4-H Program Coordinator, met with the board to give an update on Cottonwood County's 4-H Programming during 2016 and informed the board of some new 4-H programs she is working on for 2017. Reith also gave a Lego Robotics demonstration.

Nick Anderson, County Attorney, met with the board to request his cell phone reimbursement be lowered from \$75 to \$60. Motion by Gravley, second by Holmen, unanimous vote to adjust Nick Anderson's cell phone reimbursement to \$60 effective February 1, 2017.

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JinYeene Neumann, County Engineer/Public Works Director, met with the board to discuss the addition of an Assistant Maintenance Superintendent at the Public Works Department. Neumann stated this position would be 60% help for the Highway Maintenance Superintendent, 30% permitting, and 10% engineering. Consensus of the board is for Commissioners Gravley and Appel to meet with the County Engineer/Public Works Director and the Highway Maintenance Superintendent, then bring to a future work session, date to be determined.

Motion by Gravley, second by Stevens, unanimous vote to set 2017 meeting dates for the 1st & 3rd Tuesday of each month as presented with the exception of July 5 and December 6; that all meetings will begin at 9:00 a.m. with the exception of June 21 – Board of Equalization and December 19 – Truth in Taxation, which will be afternoon meetings; and that 12 additional work sessions can be scheduled with no per diems.

Motion by Schmidt to raise meal rates for 2017 by \$2.00. Motion failed due to lack of a second. Motion by Holmen, second by Gravley, to raise meal rates for 2017 by \$1.00 as follows: \$9.75 for breakfast, \$14.75 for lunch and \$18.50 for evening meal. Voting Aye – Holmen, Stevens, Gravley, and Appel. Voting Nay – Schmidt. These amounts include a 20% gratuity.

Motion by Gravley, second by Holmen, to raise the clerk hire and seasonal wages 2% for 2017. Wages are set as follows: clerk hire \$12.33/hour; seasonal wages at $$10.25 - 1^{st}$ year; $$10.56 - 2^{nd}$ year; $$10.87 - 3^{rd}$ year; $$11.19 - 4^{th}$ year; $$11.55 - 5^{th}$ year.

Motion by Schmidt, second by Stevens, unanimous vote to pay Auditor warrants with regular and customary payments for 2017, which might include: payroll and associated payables; utilities; bond payments; contract payments; payment to other government entities; tax settlements; refunds; reissue voids; well sealing; sewer loan contract payments; insurance payments and lease payments.

Motion by Gravley, second by Schmidt, unanimous vote to re-designate official Cottonwood County Brokers as follows: First Empire Securities – Hauppauge, NY; Multi-Bank Securities – Southfield, MI; Wells Fargo Advisors – Minneapolis; and Piper Jaffray – Minneapolis.

Motion by Holmen, second by Schmidt, unanimous vote to accept the bid received from the Citizen for the Official County Newspaper for 2017.

Motion by Gravley, second by Stevens, unanimous vote to set the 2017 Contingency Fund for the County Attorney's office at \$2,500.00.

Motion by Holmen, second by Schmidt, unanimous vote to leave the per diem for committee members other than commissioners at \$75 per meeting for 2017.

Motion by Schmidt, second by Stevens, unanimous roll call vote to approve Resolution 17-01-03 approving participation in the Cottonwood County Home

Initiative Program as follows:

Resolution Approving Participation In the Cottonwood County Home Initiative Program

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes §469.1812 through 469.1815 gives authority to Cottonwood County to grant an abatement of taxes imposed by the County if certain criteria are met; and

WHEREAS, Cottonwood County has been in discussions with Governing Bodies in Cottonwood County regarding participation in the tax abatement program known as the "Cottonwood County Home Initiative Program"; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Cottonwood County Home Initiative is to provide incentives to encourage the construction of new owner-occupied and rental residential housing units, encourage replacement of dilapidated housing structures within Cottonwood County, and increase future tax revenues in Cottonwood County; and

WHEREAS, an eligible participant in the program would be any person who constructs a new single-family home, duplex, or multi-family complex and who files application material and seeks formal approval from the appropriate local jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the statutory requirements, Cottonwood County has reviewed the approved Cottonwood County Home Initiative guidelines which must be met before an abatement of taxes will be granted for residential development; and

WHEREAS, individual applications requesting tax abatement for new residential construction projects in Cottonwood County will come before the Cottonwood County Board of Commissioners for approval; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Cottonwood County and its citizens that the cities and schools in Cottonwood County participate in the Cottonwood County Home Initiative Program as proposed.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COTTONWOOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA, as follows:

- 1. The Cottonwood County's participation in the Cottonwood County Home Initiative Program is hereby approved.
- 2. The Board of Commissioners retains the authority for final approval of individual projects requesting tax abatement by the Cottonwood County.
- 3. The Board of Commissioners are hereby authorized to sign any required documents authorizing the Cottonwood County's participation in the Cottonwood County Home Initiative Program.

Motion by Gravley, second by Stevens, unanimous vote to approve adding Martin Mollenhauer, GIS Specialist, to the cell phone user list and to reimburse him \$60 per month for the use of his personal cell phone for work-related matters effective, January 1, 2017.

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Motion by Schmidt, second by Holmen, unanimous vote to hire Heather Janssen, Jennifer Etchason, and Jacob Samdal as part-time Jailer/Dispatchers, on Range 11, Step A (\$18.12/hour), contingent upon successful completion of all hiring requirements. Thongvivong stated that all three pending employees will start in January.

Motion by Stevens, second by Schmidt, unanimous vote to accept the resignation from Hector Macias as part-time jailer/dispatcher effective January 12, 2017, with appropriate payout of benefits.

Motion by Schmidt, second by Holmen, unanimous vote to accept the resignation from Joel Rostomily as full-time Heavy Equipment Operator effective February 17, 2017 with appropriate payout of benefits.

Kelly Thongvivong, County Coordinator, informed the board that she received an annual survey from MRCC that needs to be completed. The board took a few

minutes during the meeting to complete the survey.

Thongvivong informed the board that there will be a SRDC orientation meeting on February 4, 2017.

Thongvivong informed the board that the federal mileage rate for 2017 has been set at \$0.535 per mile.

Motion by Gravley, second by Stevens, unanimous vote to pay a per diem to Commissioners that attend the Pipeline Safety meeting in Windom on February 6, 2017.

Motion by Holmen, second by Schmidt, unanimous vote to recess as the County Board and to convene as the Ditch Authority.

Motion by Schmidt, second by Gravley to approve the 2017 ditch levies as submitted.

Jan Johnson, Auditor/Treasurer, informed the board that the redetermination of Judicial Ditch #1 should be completed in 2017.
